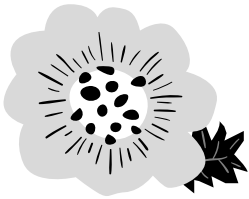

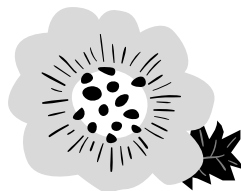
Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind.

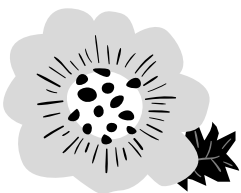


PHIL. 2:3-4

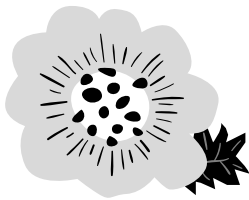
Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

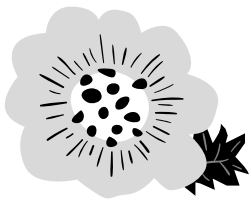
But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.

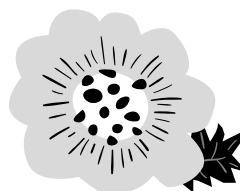

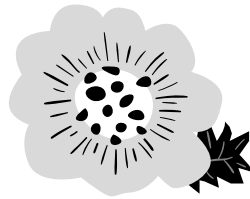
