



# Psalm 119

## Verse

Psalm 119:10 - With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments.

## Questions to Answer

What does it mean to seek the Lord?

'Commandments' means 'God's Word.' How are we tempted to wander from his commandments?


What other words are used in Psalm 119 that mean 'commandments'?

## For Mom

How do you show your kids the value you place on the Bible?

Note the ways we are to respond to God's Word according to Psalm 119.

Write down one new thing you learned about God's Word from Psalm 119.





## Activity

Draw and cut out two hearts from construction paper. Staple the sides together to make a pocket opening at the top. On strips of paper, write answers to question one (how we seek the Lord) or write verses from Psalm 119 and slip them in the paper 'heart.'

## Weekly Challenge

Remind your kids throughout the week why the Bible is so important, not just for you but for them. Talk about the different words the psalmist used in Psalm 119 to describe God's Word (law, statutes, precepts, testimonies, etc).
